## Important Information

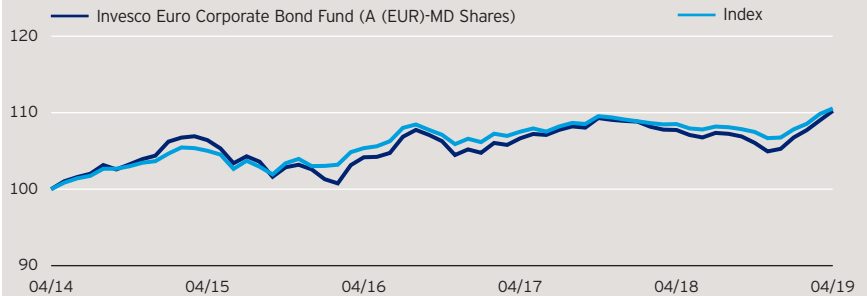
