Important Information

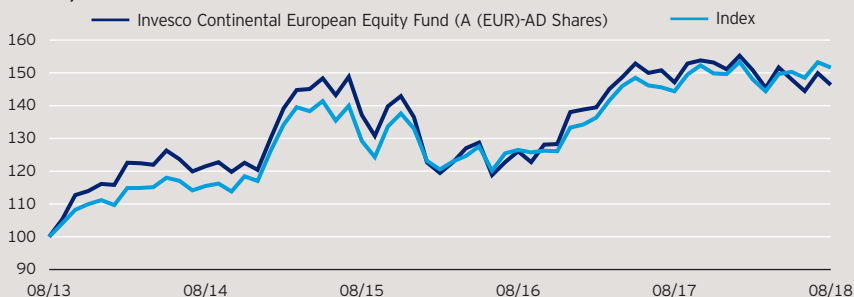
